

## 'Funds no problem if ideas are good'

**Visakhapatnam:** Funding mechanism for women entrepreneurs was highlighted by Vizag MP K Haribabu during an interactive session with women entrepreneurs at IIM-Vizag on Tuesday.

Addressing a gathering of women entrepreneurs numbering 25 at the temporary IIM-V campus located inside Andhra University premises, Haribabu spoke about the various funding mechanisms established by the central government such as the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY) and

Stand Up India, which help women entrepreneurs get funding for their ventures by doing away with red tape.

The city MP further said that ministries such as skill development, entrepreneurship and food processing could be tapped for further incentives for women entrepreneur-led start-ups. He said funds would not be a problem if the ideas are good, keeping in view the number of private investors and venture capital firms. "Every felt need around us and every unmet gap in the society is an opportunity for entrepreneurs," he said.
